- 1<sup>st</sup> Language Technologies Conference 1998
  - organized by Tomaž Erjavec, Vojko Gorjanc, Jerneja Žganec and Anica Rant
  - development and application of language technologies for Slovene
  - 26 papers: speech technologies and phonology, computer- assisted translation and teaching, corpora, encoding standards for language data, searching for information on the internet
  - establishment of the Slovenian language technologies society













#### Where we are today


- 20<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY !!!
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Language Technologies and Digital Humanities Conference
- 52 papers submitted
- 47 papers accepted (87% acceptance rate), 96 authors
  - 2 talks invited talks
  - 36 regular full papers and 5 abstracts
  - 4 student papers
- topics
  - digital humanities (16)
  - language technologies (11)
  - corpus linguistics (10)
  - language resources (8)
  - infrastructure (2)
- 48 reviewers
  - most papers reviewed by 3 reviewers, 150 reviews in total


Country of all authors of articles: Europe without Brazil (1) and Japan (1)
